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Bid packages for furnishing all plant labor, equipment, materials and performing all work necessary for this project. This bid package will be available, Wednesday, December 11, 2019 and due electronically via Quest Construction Data Network (CDN) no later than **2:00 p.m., local time, Monday, January 20, 2020**. A pre-bid meeting and tour of the project site will be held at the Jones Island Water Reclamation Facility, Maintenance Building 280, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room 700 East Jones Street, Milwaukee, WI 53207 at 1:00 p.m., Thursday, January 9, 2019.

Bid results may be publicly viewed, Monday, January 20, 2020 no later than 2:30 p.m., electronically on Quest CDN website, [www.veolianorthamerica.com/milwaukee/](http://www.veolianorthamerica.com/milwaukee/), or the Veolia Procurement Office, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Maintenance Building #280, located at the Jones Island Water Reclamation Facility, 700 East Jones Street, Milwaukee, WI 53207. The project contemplated herein consists of replacing a drain valve in the containment pit between the polymer and ferric storage tanks in Building 256. The work shall also include replacement of the drain pipe from the valve to the catch basin outside the building and all associated surface restoration. All contractor and subcontractor employees shall obtain specific site plant safety training from Veolia Water prior to working on the site. Veolia Water will offer a total of two one-hour training sessions to the contractor and any subcontractors. The Contractor shall adhere to all Veolia Water safety policy and procedures.

Veolia has implemented online project bidding using Quest CDN. For this contract, Veolia will only accept electronic bids through Quest CDN. Bids are to be submitted online at [www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com).

The Contract Documents may be viewed and downloaded by registering with Quest CDN online ([www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com)) or calling (952-233-1632). The contract is Quest Project # 6617017. A contractor may view the Contract Documents at no cost on the Quest CDN website prior to deciding to become a Planholder. To be considered a Planholder, a contractor must register on QuestCDN.com and purchase the Contract Documents, in digital form for downloading, at a cost of \$25.00. Registering as a Planholder is recommended for all prime contractors and subcontractors because Planholders will receive addendums and other contract document updates via Quest CDN.

The time for completion of the Contract shall be ninety (90) days from the date of Notice to Proceed.

Veolia Water reserves its rights to reject any Bid, to reject all Bids, and any bid not conforming to the intent of the invitation for bids and to postpone the award of the Contract for a period of time not exceeding forty five (45) days from the bid opening date. Bids shall remain firm and may not be withdrawn during this forty five (45) day period.

Veolia Water reserves its rights to waive any informality or deficiency in any Bid, to accept any Bid, to negotiate modifications of any Bid with any Bidder and accept any modified Bid, and to rebid the Project, all at Veolia Water's sole discretion.
